<u>Why:</u> To show your support for people with Alzheimer's disease and the loved ones who care for them. **Fact:** In 2012, there were 925 Alzheimer's disease related deaths in Mississippi.

Fact: Currently, more than 51,000 Mississippians live with Alzheimer's disease.

Fact: By 2025, it is estimated more than 65,000 Mississippians will have Alzheimer's disease.

Fact: Deaths from Alzheimer's increased 109 percent between 2000 and 2012, while deaths from other major diseases, including the number one cause of death (heart disease), decreased.

Fact: There were 205,000 Caregivers in 2014 with a value of unpaid care of \$2.8 billion.
