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### **Best Practices for Youth with Behavioral Health Needs involved with the Juvenile Justice System (REL-HHS-0-BPYJJS)**

This course will provide clinicians working in behavioral health organizations that provide assessment and treatment services to justice-involved youth with important information on common behavioral health disorders among justice-involved youth and assessment and treatment approaches. You will also learn about important legal issues involving sharing treatment information with juvenile justice personnel and things you can do to enhance positive outcomes of justice-involved youth. *Credit Hours: 1.75*

### **Best Practices for Delivering Telehealth (REL-BH-0-TELE3)**

This course aims to teach you about different modalities of treatment using telehealth in the behavioral health sciences, including a description of the most effective approaches. You will gain knowledge about building and maintaining rapport with clients remotely via telehealth. You also will learn about the strengths and weaknesses of telehealth practice, including ways to address those weaknesses. *Credit Hours: 1*

### **Prevention of Substance Use for Transitional Aged Youth REL-BH-0-ADD4**

The information in this training aims to inform you about best practices for delivery of substance use disorder prevention or early intervention programs for TAY. The settings in which you deliver this content may include schools, colleges, universities, community mental health centers, and substance use disorder outreach programs. Specifically, you will dissect prevention and early intervention programs that have been shown to be effective when working with this population. *Credit Hours: 1*
