Scope

All DMH Certified Providers

Purpose

To provide clarification of DMH Standard 13.2 D of the 2014 version of the DMH Operational Standards for Mental Health, Intellectual/Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Community Service Providers.

Subject

DMH Standard 13.2 D should read as follows:

Crisis Stabilization Units and Primary Substance Abuse Rehabilitation and Treatment Programs with certified capacities of <u>sixteen (16) or less</u> participants shall meet the requirements as set forth in the Residential Inspection Report issued by the Mississippi State Department of Health.

DMH has partnered with the MS State Department of Health (MSDH) to provide clarification regarding the needed inspections conducted by MSDH through their district offices. Should you encounter difficulty in obtaining the needed inspections for programs certified by DMH, please contact the DMH Bureau of Quality Management, Operations and Standards so that DMH can continue to work with MSDH to resolve any challenges that may be encountered.
