**Subject:** Transportation as a Component of ID/DD Waiver Living and Day Services

**Scope**

All DMH/H Certified Providers

**Purpose**

To provide clarification of expected implementation of Rules 28.1, 28.3 and 33.2 of the DMH Operational Standards.

**Subject**

Rules 28.1. H (Day Services Adult), 28.3. K (Prevocational Services) and 33.2 (Supervised Living) of the DMH Operational Standards all require transportation as a component of service provision.

The following is being provided as clarification regarding the responsibilities for transportation:

- Providers of Supervised Living Services are responsible for transportation of individuals served to activities chosen by the individual, healthcare appointments, employment etc. as indicated in Rule 33.2 of the DMH Operational Standards.
- Providers of Prevocational Services and Day Services Adult are responsible for transportation of individuals to and from the day programs as indicated in Rules 28.1 and 28.3 of the DMH Operational Standards. This requirement includes individuals who may live in family homes, Supported Living Service settings, and Supervised Living Service settings.
