Ms. Bailey reported that May is Mental Health Month, and in reconigition, DMH is hosting a "Mental Health Meet Up" next Wednesday, May 25 at 2 p.m. at the Two Mississippi Museums Trustmark Community Room in Jackson.

Ms. Bailey reported that as part of mental health awareness observances in May, the first week of May is recognized as Children's Mental Health Acceptance Week.

Ms. Bailey reported that two virtual community forums were held on May 11 and 12 exploring the needs of Mississippi's behavioral health crisis system.

Ms. Bailey shared copies of the The National Association of State Mental Health Program Directors Research Institute (NRI) reports and provided highlights.

Ms. Bailey shared a list of proposed Board meeting locations for the FY23 fiscal year. Ms. Bailey made a recommendation to change the August 18, 2022 meeting from South Mississippi Regional Center to Ellisville State School.

On a motion by Dr. Killebrew and a second by Mr. Rutledge, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Board meeting locations for the FY23 fiscal year with the recommended change.

Ms. Bailey shared copies of the most recent news articles.

Ms. Bailey reported the June 2022 Board of Mental Health meeting will be held at South Mississippi State Hospital, Purvis, Mississippi on June 16, 2022.

Katie Storr, Chief of Staff, presented a comprehensive overview of the NRI DMH Strategic Plan Feedback Report.

Jake Hutchins, Deputy Executive Director, Behavioral Health Services, presented the Monthly Survey Reports for East Mississippi State Hospital, South Mississippi State Hospital, and Specialized Treatment Facility. There were no significant findings during these surveys.

Dr. Mallory Malkin, Chief Clinical Officer, presented a brief overview of the Division of Children and Youth Community Mental Health Services.

Dr. Corey Jackson, Mississippi State Hospital, provided an overview of the Resident Psychotherapy Clinic that will open on July 1, 2022.

Lynn Knight, Performance Improvement Coordinator and Sommer Armstrong, Public Relations Director, North Mississippi State Hospital, provided an update

on actions NMSH has taken on ligature risks and networking and mental health meetings.

Craig Kittrell, Deputy Executive Director, IDD Services presented the Monthly Survey Report for North Mississippi Regional Center. There were no significant findings during these surveys.

Patient Care Subcommittee Report:

Dr. Sara Gleason reported that the Patient Care Subcommittee met prior to the Board meeting. She made a recommendation due to the absence of Dr. Griffin and Dr. Shivangi to table the vote until next month pending committee members final reviews.
