



## SYSTEM OF SERVICE

# ALCOHOL AND DRUG PREVENTION, TREATMENT AND RECOVERY SUPPORT SERVICES

The Department of Mental Health, Division of Alcohol and Drug Addiction Treatment Services, administers the public system of substance use assessment, referral, prevention, treatment, and recovery support services for individuals in Mississippi. The division is also responsible for establishing, maintaining, and evaluating the network of service providers, which includes regional community mental health centers and other nonprofit community-based programs.

The Division of Alcohol and Drug Addiction Treatment Services has the responsibility of administering fiscal resources (state and federal) to the public system of prevention, treatment, and recovery supports for persons with substance use disorders. The overall goal of the state's substance use disorder service system is to provide quality care within a continuum of accessible community-based services including prevention, outpatient, withdrawal management, intensive outpatient, high-intensity and low-intensity residential treatment, opioid treatment services and recovery support.

The Community Mental Health Centers (CMHCs) are the foundation of the substance use disorder delivery system. In addition, East MS State Hospital has 50 beds for men, MS State Hospital has 25 beds for women with a Substance Use Disorder, and some centers offer services for specialized populations such as children and adolescents, the elderly and pregnant/parenting women.

There are also several other public and private agencies that provide prevention, treatment, and recovery support services. These entities also provide services for special populations and may receive funding from other state agencies, community service agencies or donations.

#### **ACUTE PARTIAL HOSPITALIZATION PROGRAM**

The Acute Partial Hospitalization Program for Substance Use Disorders provides an intensity of treatment similar to an inpatient environment, in a less restrictive, community-based setting. This short-term, intensive level of care allows individuals to benefit from consistent, structured treatment while maintaining their usual living arrangements in their communities. Acute partial hospitalization programs provide a less restrictive level of care for individuals discharged from inpatient programs, or a higher level of care when IOP is not effectively meeting the individual's needs. #### **OPIOID TREATMENT SERVICES**

Opioid treatment programs provide withdrawal management services to people suffering from chronic addiction to opiates or opiate derivatives. The services support the individual by utilizing methadone, and/or buprenorphine while the individual participates in a spectrum of counseling and other recovery support services to assist the person with successful recovery from opiate addiction. #### WITHDRAWAL MANAGEMENT

Withdrawal Management is the process through which a person who is physically and/or psychologically dependent on alcohol, illegal drugs, prescription medications, or a combination of these drugs is withdrawn from the drugs of dependence. Programs must use the American Society for Addiction Medicine (ASAM) levels of care to determine compliance with withdrawal management standards. The DUI diagnostic assessment is a process by which a diagnostic test is administered, and the result is combined with other required information to determine the offender's appropriate treatment environment. Multiple treatment modalities, techniques and strategies include individual, group, and family counseling. #### **INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT SERVICES (IOP)**

The Level 2.1 Intensive Outpatient Program is a community-based outpatient program which provides an alternative to traditional residential treatment or hospital settings. IOPs generally provide 9-19 hours of structured programming per week for adults consisting primarily of counseling and education about addiction and mental health problems. IOPs are for adults who need services more intensive than traditional outpatient services, but who have less severe alcohol and drug problems than those typically addressed in residential treatment. The IOP allows the consumer to continue to fulfill his/ her obligations to family, job, and community while continuing treatment. Programs must use the American Society for Addiction Medicine (ASAM) levels of care to determine compliance with DMH's Operational Standards on Level 2.1: Intensive Outpatient Services. #### ADOLESCENT INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT SERVICES (A-IOP)

Adolescent-Intensive Outpatient Program community-based outpatient program for adolescents ages 12-18 who need services more intensive than traditional outpatient services, but who have less severe alcohol and other drug disorders than those typically addressed in Residential Treatment Services. A-IOPs allows adolescents to continue to fulfill their obligations to family, job, school, and community while obtaining treatment. Programs must use the American Society for Addiction Medicine (ASAM) levels of care to determine compliance with DMH's Operational Standards on Level 2.1: Intensive Outpatient Services. Recovery Support Services include social supports, linkage to and coordination among allied service providers, and other resources to improve quality of life for people in and seeking recovery, while also supporting their families. Services are provided by professionals and peers and are delivered through a variety of community and faith-based groups, treatment providers, and RSS providers. #### CLINICALLY MANAGED RESIDENTIAL SERVICES

Level 3.5: Clinically Managed High-Intensity Residential Programs for Adults and Clinically Managed Medium-Intensity Residential Programs for Adolescents Residential Substance Use Disorder Treatment Program is an intensive program for individuals who are addicted to or use alcohol, drugs, and/or opioids. Level 3.5 programs are designed to serve individuals who, because of specific function limitations, need safe and stable living environments in order to develop and/or demonstrate sufficient recovery skills. This type of treatment offers a 24-hour supportive treatment and group living environment that provides the individual with a comprehensive program of services which are easily accessible and responsive to the needs of the individual. Because substance and opioid misuse is a multidimensional problem, group and individual therapy, family therapy, education services explaining alcohol/drug and dependency, personal growth, and the recovery process, vocational counseling and rehabilitation services, employment activities, and recreational and social activities are available to the individual. Programs must use the American Society for Addiction Medicine (ASAM) levels of care to determine compliance with DMH's Operational Standards on Level Clinically Managed High-Intensity and Medium Intensity Residential Programs. ## CLINICALLY MANAGED LOW-INTENSITY RESIDENTIAL SERVICES

A residential substance use disorder treatment program focuses on the enhancement of social skills needed to lead a productive fulfilling life in the community, Level 3.1 programs offer at least 5 hours per week of low intensity treatment for substance-related disorders. The program provides a group living environment, which promotes life free from chemical dependency, while encouraging the pursuit of vocational, employment or related opportunities. With group support, individuals acquire coping skills which enable them to become productive citizens in their community. An individual must have successfully completed a High-Intensity Residential substance use disorder treatment program before being eligible for admission. Programs must use the American Society for Addiction Medicine (ASAM) levels of care to determine compliance with DMH's Operational Standards on Level 3.1: Clinically Managed Low-Intensity Residential Programs. #### PROGRAM CAPACITIES

The following alcohol and drug addiction treatment programs are assessed bi-annually by Independent Peer Reviewers (IPRs). IPRs use the Dual Diagnosis Capability in Addiction Treatment (DDCAT) Index or the Dual Diagnosis Capability in Mental Health Treatment (DDCMHT) Index to help service organizations to assess their capability and capacity to provide treatment for people diagnosed with a mental illness who also have a co-occurring substance use disorder and to develop and implement a plan to do so with increasing capacity over time. These assessments further explore an organization's program areas or dimensions: policies, program structure, program milieu, clinical practices (assessment and treatment), continuity of care, workforce capacities (staffing), and training. Each of these program areas or dimensions receives a score. Based on the program's overall score, the program or agency is categorized as: AOS (Addiction Only Services), MHOS (Mental Health Only Services), DDC (Dual Diagnosis Capable primary focus is mental health; co-occurring disorders are treated), or DDE (Dual Diagnosis Enhanced - primary focus on persons with co-occurring disorders).


