Scope

All IDD community service providers

Purpose

To inform IDD community service providers of the discontinued need for data entry into the WITS system

Background

The 2020 Operational Standards for Mental Health, Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities and Substance Use Disorders Community Service Providers (DMH Operational Standards) addresses the requirements for providers to submit client level data to DMH.

Subject

According to Rule 2.5.D. of the DMH Operational Standards, agency providers must maintain current and accurate data for submission of all reports and data utilizing the Web Infrastructure for Treatment Services (WITS). The data must be submitted within established time frames, as required by the DMH Provider Contract and Billing Manual and the Data Warehouse Submission Guidelines.

Due to changing data reporting needs, **IDD community service providers will no longer be required to enter data into WITS effective December 1, 2022**. If data reporting needs change in the future, the requirement may be reinstated.
