Subject: Additional position under Physician/Psychiatric Services referral eligibility for Mississippi Youth Programs Around the Clock (MYPAC)

Issue Date: January 12, 2023

Effective Date: Immediately

Scope

All DMH Certified Providers and DMH-Operated Agencies providing MYPAC services.

Purpose

To clarify additional position under the Physician/Psychiatric Services category for MYPAC referrals.

Subject

DMH Certified Agency Providers providing MYPAC services must comply with current *DMH Operational Standards*, Part 2: Chapter 32, Rule 32.19.

This bulletin clarifies the inclusion of Developmental-Behavioral Pediatricians under the Physician/Psychiatric Services category for MYPAC referrals. In addition to the categories of professionals indicated in the current *DMH Operational Standards* document who can make MYPAC referrals, MYPAC Providers are also authorized to receive referrals for MYPAC from Developmental-Behavioral Pediatricians (i.e., pediatricians trained in developmental-behavioral assessments/treatment) to meet the admissions criteria of children/youth into their programs.

Questions regarding Medicaid reimbursement should be directed to the Mississippi Division of Medicaid (DOM).
