There was a lot of discussion on ensuring that we have strong requirements for peer and family services. In general, Steering Committee members want to ensure that CCBHCs are required to offer the most comprehensive and complete peer support services.</p> <p>Due to timing we delayed reviewing the workforce development and final community needs assessment results. Those will be covered at the November 14th meeting. All Steering Committee members were provided a written update that they could review in advance of the November meeting.</p>
