The event and update received a lot of positive feedback, including interest from many stakeholders in participating in next year's event.</p> <p>Committee members were asked to distribute and secure similar proclamations as the State Board and Region 6 from their communities.</p> <p>Kate McMillan from the Division of Medicaid, and Amy Swanson CCBHC Project Co-Director gave an overview of the nine CCBHC services, as well as details on what services will remain fee-for-service, outside of the PPS-1 rate. These services were Wraparound Facilitation (In-person and Telehealth); and MYPAC.</p> <p>Kate McMillan shared the reason these services will remain outside of the PPS-1 rate is that there are no prior authorization requirement for these services delivered under the PPS 1 rate. PA will still be required for services delivered under FFS. On the CCBHC Scope of Services, these fee-for-service CCBHC services include: Wraparound Facilitation and Wraparound Facilitation Telehealth; and MYPAC.</p>

<p>Offer an opportunity to give feedback on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Workforce Development Plan. • Final from the Community Needs Assessment. • DRAFT Family/Client Engagement Playbook • 	<p>Assessment Results.</p>	<p>Committee members shared positive feedback on the inclusion of: CIT training; court, community liaisons; and school based services as a covered PPS-1 activities.</p> <p>Amy Swanson CCBHC Project Co-Director shared details with the Committee on the updated DRAFT certification criteria. The schedule for distributing this was announced, along with the details for CMHCs to participate in five feedback sessions in December and January to secure feedback and ask questions.</p> <p>Committee members expressed concerns around the state imposing too many additional requirements to the federal CCBHC requirements. They were very concerned about requirements for EBPs, citing costs and workforce issues as a barrier.</p> <p>DMH shared EBPs are a requirement for the federal CCBHC Certification.</p> <p>Nikki Tapp, CCBHC Project Co-Director shared an update on the plan to secure input on the requirements for EBPs. She shared that the team handled the follow-up from the October 10th Steering Committee meeting. 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		<p>recommended EBPs to include in Mississippi’s state CCBHC Certification Criteria.</p> <p>Heidi Arthur, a consultant for the CCBHC Planning Grant, shared an outline of the DRAFT Family/Client engagement playbook and/or resource guide.</p> <p>Committee members asked a lot of questions about the rationale for developing this resource, as well as why state-based organizations weren’t consulted. Ms. Arthur shared that a small working group comprised of representatives from our two pilot regions developed a DRAFT document so that we could bring someone to a larger forum for people to react to. She shared that sessions are scheduled for November and December to secure feedback.</p> <p>DMH committed to distributing the draft via email to all committee members for input.</p>
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
