The Operational Standards for Mental Health, Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities and Substance Use Disorders Community Service Providers (DMH Operational Standards) states that some positions and services must participate in DMH-approved trainings and/or certifications. This bulletin provides the Addendum of DMH-approved trainings and/or certifications where applicable.

This addendum does not encompass all training requirements for every service or employee. Instead, it serves as a reference list of DMH-approved trainings and/or certifications, specifically when the standards refer to training approved by DMH.
